Certificate in **Restorative Practices**

About

This course aims to introduce the values, principles and processes for competent restorative practice and to engage learners in understanding its theory. Learners will also have an opportunity to explore the context, history and benefits of restorative practice and the range of related issues surrounding its practical use within the community.



On successful completion of the course, the learner should be able to:

- Collate evidence of their understanding of the principles relating to restorative practice and participate in assessment activities to provide evidence of their knowledge and understanding
 - Explore the range of structures and types of facilitation used within restorative practice and identified real-life situations where a restorative approach may be applied
 - To develop and share their understanding of the development of restorative practice within the community and confirm their understanding of the core values and principles for good practice
- Develop an awareness of the roles and responsibilities in the Restorative Practice process
 - Show an understanding of what community means

- Background to Restorative Practice
- Application of Restorative Practice Skills
- Understanding Empathy and Developing a Restorative Practice
